McMURRAY WATERCOLOR CLASS DESCRIPTION

Intermediate to advanced

Class will start each day with a demonstration at about 10 am, which lasts about 1-1/2 2 hours, after which students will work on their own paintings until approximately 3:00 pm (break for lunch or work while you eat). During this period I will be in class working with students on an individual basis. Then we stop at about 3:00 for a group critique of about one hour before breaking for the day. Class is usually finished around 4:00 or 4:30, depending on the number of students.

I will provide a materials list upon request, but students should bring whatever materials they usually use and are comfortable with.

Although this is not a beginners class, beginners are welcome but they should have some drawing experience or at least some experience with another medium and be prepared to hear many things related to techniques and design principles that they may not be ready for.

Students working in other media are welcome, i.e.: oils, acrylics, however I will critique those works from a design and expression standpoint only. In those cases I will not offer technical critiques related to the medium; i.e.: information related to instruments, brushes, pigments, mediums or supports, in media other than watercolor.
