2 Day Watermedia workshop titled “ Experiment for Fun, Design and Success on YUPO”

with nationally known Pittsburgh artist and multi award winner, Eileen Sudzina PWS-sgg.

Dates: March 13 & 20 (2 Wednesdays) 10AM-4PM (1 hr for lunch)

Participants will create paintings on yupo and see how easy it really is. There will be discussions on the wholeness of the work, the importance of color schemes, and design.

Participant’s will paint intuitively from within and these paintings will be as fun and seem to paint themselves right in front of our eyes. There will be both group and individualized instruction and demos. All levels are welcome as long as everyone is comfortable with their materials.

Day 1 class:

- Talk and demo the techniques to paint on yupo as opposed to watercolor paper.
- Demo a floral painting, spontaneous, loose, and free.
- Touch on color, design, flow and how to make it work everytime.
- Get past fear and into FUN.
- Students get to paint two or more pieces. I will give group individual help.
- Talk about negative shapes and predesign using painters tape or frisket for preparing a more detailed piece(s) for day 2 class. (I will demo draw up a tree scene and discuss lights to save)

Day 2 class:

- I will demo paint a more detailed piece(s). I will talk through out the demo as to why I am doing what I am doing and what thoughts are on my mind as I paint.
- Objectively look at your piece as a whole and do what it takes to fix problems and MAKE IT HAPPEN.
- Yupo is very forgiving, it is an excellent way to learn to paint because it can endlessly be changed.

- If anyone wants their piece to be talked about and what I would do with it I will, if no volunteers I'll bring a few old problem ones of mine that will be improved upon..
